Escape Rooms

What are they?

An escape room, also known as an "escape game", is a physical or digital adventure game in which players solve a series of puzzles and riddles using clues, hints, and strategy to complete the objectives at hand. Players are given a set time limit to unveil the secret plot which is hidden within the room/s. Games are set in a variety of fictional locations, such as tombs, prison cells, dungeons, and space stations, and usually the various puzzles and riddles themselves follow the theme of the room.



How does it work?



You and a team of people are "locked" in a room filled with mysterious objects. You will have 30 minutes to investigate, find clues, and solve puzzles in order to meet your objective/s and to escape the room.

Some of the puzzles an escape room can contain are – hidden objects, using something in an unusual way, noticing something obvious in the room, symbol substitution, word puzzles, ciphers, riddles and many more. An example is - you find a blank piece of paper in one area of the room and in another, you find some sort of torch. Hidden instructions or clues are revealed on the blank piece of paper when you shine the torch on the paper. Hint, it was a black light torch!

What do you get out of it?

Escape rooms are great ways to test your own minds and to start thinking in different directions. Not only are they great team building experiences they can also be used as a teaching tool. They help groups work together, collaborate, learn & share information and solve problems by using interpersonal communication skills. Not only that, they are a fun and informal way for groups to bond and compete together and strive for the first place on the leader board.



How do YOU play?



In groups you will be tasked to escape both our physical and digital escape rooms. In order to escape both rooms your knowledge of Australian legislation & case law will be tested.

You can ask for hints and clues along the way if you get stuck on a puzzle.

Anything can be a clue so make sure you look at/click on everything you possibly can. However, no clues need to be forced open. Please be respectively of the items in the rooms and treat them with care.
